Re your recent emails:

Thanks you for your suggestion but I will not meet Ferhat Kaya on this particular visit to the region. I have a very full programme and in any case do not wish to confuse matters as my colleagues in Ankara are dealing with the comments he has made to the ECGD and will make their response in due course.

With regard to the list of ESIA support documents you have asked for, it would be helpful if you could tell us what issues are of interest to you. The ESIA summarises information from maps which are regarded as Sensitive by the Turkish authorities and we are not able to distribute them without reference. An alternative is for you or your colleagues to visit our Ankara office to see them. This could probably be arranged if we give them adequate prior notice.

I will be away this week so will unfortunately miss your briefing at the Foreign Press Association on Monday but hope to see you at next Friday's Chatham House session on BTC. If you have any queries in the meantime, Clare Bebbington will try to help.
